

SNOW EMERGENCY PLAN - CLARIFICATION ON PARTIAL MAKEUPS DUE TO SNOW EMERGENCIES

What Is The Re-Schedule Policy For Regular Session Play - During the regular session (up until the last two weeks of the session) any and all un-played matches will be officially re-scheduled at the original Hosting Location for 2:00pm ON THE SECOND SATURDAY immediately following your regular night of play (or as listed on the APA website, voice mail, or as posted in make-up notices/bulletins). If a match needs to be re-scheduled during the last two weeks of the session, it will be re-scheduled at the original Hosting Location for 2:00 pm on the “first” Saturday following your regular night of play (or as listed on the APA website, voice mail, or as posted in make-up notices/bulletins). If that location is not open at 2:00 pm, use the same rules as covered under the section (Host Locations Temporarily Closed). If both teams agree, matches may be made up “prior” to the re-schedule date, but not after (unless approved by the League Operator). **If a team, for any reason, cannot make a re-scheduled match date, they will not have to forfeit.**

If the teams have 3 or more matches left to make-up, points will be awarded as follows:

In 8-Ball, if a team doesn't show up for the make-up match, that team will receive a TOTAL of 7 points, while the team that physically showed up will receive a TOTAL of 8 points. In our 9-Ball and Mixed Format leagues, if a team doesn't show up, that team will receive 50 TOTAL points, while the team that showed up will receive 60 TOTAL points. The team that was present must wait the required 15 minutes and then list the name of the bar staff person they spoke with and the time they left the facility in the REMARKS section on the SK App.

If neither team shows up for the make-up match, each team will be awarded a TOTAL of 50 points in 9-Ball and 7 points in 8-Ball, however full weekly fees are still required for all scheduled matches (played or not). If weekly fees are received in the office by 10am on Monday following the make-up date, the teams will also receive their bonus points. A similar points system would be used for our Masters and our Ladies leagues.

If the teams played 3 or more prior matches, and only have one or two matches left to make-up, points will be awarded as follows:

In 8-Ball, if a team doesn't show up for the make-up match, they will still receive 1 additional point for each un-played match ... or ... a TOTAL of 7 points, whichever is higher. The team that physically shows up will receive 2 additional points for each un-played match ... or ... a TOTAL of 8 points, whichever is higher.

In our 9-Ball and Mixed Format leagues, if a team doesn't show up for the make-up match, they will receive 8 additional points for each un-played match ... or ... a TOTAL of 50 points, whichever is higher. The team that physically showed up will receive 12 additional points for each un-played match, or a TOTAL of 60 points, whichever is higher. The team that was present must wait the required 15 minutes and then list the name of the bar staff person they spoke with and the time they left the facility, in the REMARKS on the SK App.

In 9-Ball, if neither team shows up for the make-up match, both teams will be awarded an additional 10 additional points for each un-played match ... or ... 50 TOTAL points, whichever is higher. In 8-Ball if neither team shows up for the make-up match, both teams will be awarded an additional 1 additional points for each un-played match ... or ... 7 TOTAL points, whichever is higher. Full weekly fees are still required for all scheduled matches (played or not). If weekly fees are received in the office by 10am on Monday following the make-up date, the teams will also receive their bonus points. A similar points system would be used for our Masters and our Ladies leagues.
